NTA Adds Compli CSA for its Members Compliance

Carson City, NV, January 25, 2012 – NorthAmerican Transportation Association, a national transportation benefits organization (TBO) established in 1989, has not only endorsed but has added Compli CSA to their Benefits and Services, as an effective solution to help trucking fleets efficiently manage and automate their CSA performance and compliance requirements.

The CSA experts on the American Trucking Association's staff also have reviewed Compli CSA and determined that it can help the trucking industry successfully manage their CSA compliance Programs.

Compli CSA is designed to help carriers reduce safety concerns, manage drivers, increase productivity, and help promote safe and efficient fleets. When violations are logged, the web-based Compli CSA initiates an automated process to review the violation, inspect the driver's violation history, enforce disciplinary action and re-train the driver.

Compli CSA shows possible inconsistencies in the section and violation data so that management can work with drivers to reduce their BASIC scores over time. In addition, the system allows fleets to analyze their violations and BASICs in order to identify potential problems quickly.

In an interview from NTA's California Information Center located in Signal Hill, Ca., President Wayne Schooling said, "This is just another good reason for transportation-related companies, large or small, to join our organization. There are transportation companies out there still using sub-standard means and with CSA here, it only makes sense to have a professional safety person monitoring your drivers, this fits right in."

Mr. Schooling said, "This is quite an honor because to the best of my knowledge, there is not another association that provides this service."

NorthAmerican Transportation Association is now recognized by state and federal agencies and other industry professionals as providing superior services in the field of Drug and Alcohol Testing Program Management, Driver Qualification Files, Vehicle Maintenance Files, and Hours of Service regulations, that are in compliance with all regulations.

This is NTA's third national achievement. In November 2001, NTA was awarded National Accreditation for Administration of Drug and Alcohol Testing Programs. This accreditation means that their facilities, operations and personnel meet the highest standards in areas such as regulatory compliance, client confidentiality, accountability, company service standards, operational practices, business ethics, and professional competency for drug and alcohol testing program management. A primary requirement was that the key personnel of NorthAmerican Transportation Association have attended comprehensive training on standards of program management and have passed an industry-developed exam on these policies and procedures.

In November 2006, NTA was appointed the Official U.S. DOT training site on the Internet by the Transportation Safety Institute and Advance Online Solutions Inc., offering approximately 131 on-

line courses whereby the participants can receive a Certificate of Training issued by the U.S. Department of Transportation, Transportation Safety Institute.
